BIBLE READING

John 13:1-17

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.
(John 13:14-15 - NIV)

BIBLE READING

John 19:1-19

But they shouted, “Take him away! Take him away! Crucify him!” “Shall I crucify your king?” Pilate asked. “We have no king but Caesar,” the chief priests answered. Finally Pilate handed him over to them to be crucified. So the soldiers took charge of Jesus. (John 19:15-16 - NIV)

PRAYER

Almighty God, thank you that you love us so much that you gave us Jesus who died to free us from our sin. Be with all your children today as we remember his suffering and death on the cross. Amen.

EMPTY TOMB

BIBLE READING

John 20:1-18

Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb and saw two angels in white, seated where Jesus’ body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot. They asked her, “Woman, why are you crying?” “They have taken my Lord away,” she said, “and I don’t know where they have put him.” At this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus. (John 20:11-14 - NIV)
