Growing

A weekly resource to help you connect your weekend worship with the faith life of your home. It is based on the three year cycle of church readings (called the **Lectionary**), and contains Bible readings, prayers, blessings and faith-sharing ideas for households to use each and every day.

Growing Faith at Home is an A4 sheet that can be photocopied as a double-sided A5 church bulletin insert.



Creative Response

A creative response is about making space to explore, in a creative and practical way, what we have learnt or heard through the Bible readings. It is about working as a household, family or individual to process the message as the Holy Spirit leads you.

The creative response time will allow people of all generations to work together, sharing and processing their thoughts. You can use the suggestion printed in the weekly Growing Faith at Home sheets or come up with your own.

Invite some wondering questions into your conversation. These can help to flesh out what each person is thinking... "I wonder what part of the Bible reading you like the best?" or "I wonder where you are in the story, or which part of the story is about you?"

Provide a variety of creative materials that allow all age levels and skills to empower creativity: Playdough, drawing tools including chalk boards, markers, building blocks i.e. Lego, recycled goods, etc.

Caring Conversations



Christian values and faith are passed on to the next generation through supportive conversations.



Devotions

Our faith shapes the whole of our lives and involves a lifetime of Bible study, reflection and prayer.

Service



Serving others together provides an opportunity for children to see people's gifts, faith and values in action.



Rituals and Traditions

Rituals and traditions communicate meaning, values and the relationship that exist between people and God.
