

CHOCOLATE EMPTY TOMB

Easter Sunday

You will need: Biscuits with one side chocolate (eg Westons, Arnotts or generic brand "Choc Wheaton") | Hollow Chocolate Easter Eggs | Chocolate for melting | Toothpicks | Re useable adhesive putty (eg Bluetac)

1.



Take an Easter egg and cut it in half (use a hot knife).

2.



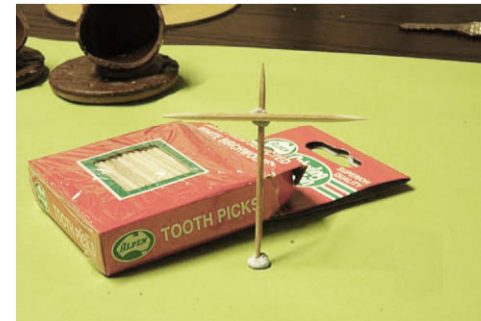
Lay the egg half on top of the biscuit, on its side so that it resembles an empty tomb.

3.



Melt some chocolate and use it to 'glue' the egg to the chocolate side of the biscuit.

4.



Fix two toothpicks together to form a cross with a piece of bluetac.

5.

Push the cross into the biscuit so that it stands next to the "tomb".
